TEEN CHARGED IN CONNECTION WITH THREATS TO FAIRFIELD CAREER CENTER

[Lancaster, Ohio, October 22, 2014] Detectives have charged Devyn P. Jacobs, 16, with one (1) count of Inducing Panic, (F-2), punishable by a minimum of one year of incarceration, or up to 21 years of age.

Sheriff Dave Phalen stated the Fairfield Career Center had to be locked down Tuesday morning after faculty discovered someone had written on the men's bathroom wall: "School go boom 10-21-14." Deputies used bomb sniffing K-9s to search the school. Once the Sheriff's Office and school officials checked the buildings, students returned to class.

Today another message was discovered, triggering a lockdown. The school was again secured and checked by bomb sniffing dogs. Detectives and deputies were able to interview several students and arrested Devyn P. Jacobs, a student of the school.
